The District Governor together with his/her appointed Cabinet and Specialist Officers within the District recognise that a positive approach to health and safety is a fundamental part of effective and efficient management.


The Health and Safety standards which are set out in both the Lions Club International Policy and the Multiple District Health and Safety Policy are both recognised and endorsed by the District.

All hazards and risks associated with the activity are effectively managed to ensure as far as reasonably practicable, the safety of all who participate or may be affected by the activity.

This health and safety Policy, together with the arrangement for delivering the outputs from the policy, will be reviewed and updated on an Annual basis or sooner in the light of changes in legislation or substantial changes being made to the organisation of the District.
