District Club of the Year for Service in the Community

Instructions for submitting nomination.

In the spirit of Lionism, the more clubs that participate will demonstrate the high level of service and fund raising activities in their respective communities. Also, the more competitive the award is the greater the significance of the recognition.

The award was developed to give equal weighting regardless of the number of club members, locality and amount of funds raised. Every Lions Club has an equal chance of winning!

The Club Secretary should complete the nomination in the format that follows with documentation when appropriate (e.g. photos, newspaper clipping, flyer, etc.). The nomination should be received **by 1 February before the convention date.**

FORMAT:

List activities under each category shown below. Organise the information in an Excel file.

- For each activity provide specific information/documentation such as date of project, location of project, funds raised, funds donated, etc.
- Assign points for each activity listed as specified under RULES
- Note that some categories restrict points earned to one project/activity per month
- For publicity received please provide photocopy of newspaper, magazine, newsletter article, etc.
- Please include contact details of a club member (name, email and telephone number) in the event that clarification of the submitted documentation is required

CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARD FOR "SERVICE IN THE COMMUNITY"

- **CONTEST OBJECTIVES:** To promote greater Lionistic activity in the Clubs for the Lions programme at the Club, Zone, Region, District, Multiple District and/or International levels.
- **PARTICIPATION:** All Lions Clubs are eligible.
- WINNER: The First place winner will be announced at the District Handover.
- **POINTS:** Points are given based upon values established for the items listed under "RULES". To receive credited points for the items listed, the activity must be reported on the LCI Annual Activity Report and/or documentation submitted by the Club.
- **CONTEST PERIOD:** The contest will run from 1 July to 30 June every Lionistic year. The nomination is based on the previous year and the winner announced at the Convention in the next Lionistic year.
