## **DEMENTIA TROPHY**

(Donated by PDG Sarbjit Assi in memory of Mrs Kuldip Kaur Assi)

- 1. The purpose of the Trophy is to encourage Clubs in District 105A to participate in delivery of activities for people with dementia and/or raising awareness of dementia.
- 2. The Trophy shall be presented to the winning Club at the District Convention and shall be judged on the preceding year's activity from the first day of March to the last day of February.
- 3. The competition shall be open to all Clubs in District 105A. The Trophy will be held by the winning club until won by another Club in a subsequent competition. The winning Club shall be responsible for:
  - i. The safekeeping and insurance of the Trophy whilst it is in their tenure.
  - ii. The engraving of their name on the Trophy in a similar style.
  - iii. The delivery of the Trophy to the District Competitions Officer prior to the District Convention.
- 4. The winning Club shall satisfy the following criteria:-
  - Carried out **at least three** dementia activities involving members of the public or within their local community. These may include:
    - a. Direct service activities with their community such as:
      - i. Supporting/Caring for individuals with dementia e.g. befriending, gardening, shopping, filling in forms, etc.
      - ii. Helping to create a dementia enabling environment in the home e.g. lights, décor, surroundings, etc.
      - iii. Helping out at a community centre or dementia café.
      - iv. Supporting activities at a dementia club.
    - b. Promotional awareness awareness of dementia in the community including campaigns.
    - c. Fundraising.
  - ii. The activities have been carried out in a public place and not at a Club meeting.
  - iii. The activities capture the number of people who have either engaged in or have been impacted by the activity.
  - iv. The activities have been carried out 'professionally' and have followed the District guidelines.
  - v. The activities are recorded in My Lion.
  - vi. The activities can be supported by the relevant evidence (see Section 5 below).
- 5. Applying Clubs must provide supporting evidence with their application to the District Dementia Officer in the way of:
  - a. Copy of a Club Activity Report to My Lion.
  - b. Copy of minutes from a Club Business Meeting.
  - c. Copy of Club accounts.
  - d. Copy of official letters.
  - e. Any details on Club's website/ social media.
- 6. The winning Club will be decided by the District GST Officer or the Dementia Officer in consultation with the District Governor and the trophy donor or his representative.
- 7. Any dispute or interpretation of these rules shall be made to the trophy donor or his representative.
